THE PROVISION OF PROPERTY VALUATION SERVICES FOR ALL GIPF COMMERCIAL PROPERTIES

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The Government Institutions Pension Fund (GIPF) hereby invites expressions of interest from suitable qualified and experience property valuers for the provision of property valuation services for all GIPF's commercial properties.

Scope of Work

The GIPF requires provision of property valuation services for its commercial properties in Windhoek, Swakopmund and Oshakati, respectively.

- The service provider will be expected to conduct property valuations for financial reporting purposes by adopting appropriate methods of valuation.
- The inspection and valuation reports are to be prepared in accordance with the International Valuation Standards (IVS) and include the following:
 - As Is Market value of the Property
 - Reinstatement value for Insurance Purpose
- The service provider should assume responsibility for their assessment values in the event of any dispute
- The service provider must be able to produce the valuation reports within a reasonable period of time.

Qualification Requirements:

- Be qualified and capable of undertaking commercial property valuation under consideration.
- Have a good understanding and knowledge of the commercial property market.
- Have relevant tertiary qualification i.e. diploma/degree in Property Valuation/Property studies from a recognized tertiary institution.
- Have a minimum of five (5) years' experience in commercial property valuation of which two (2) years of service was spent working in Namibian property market.
